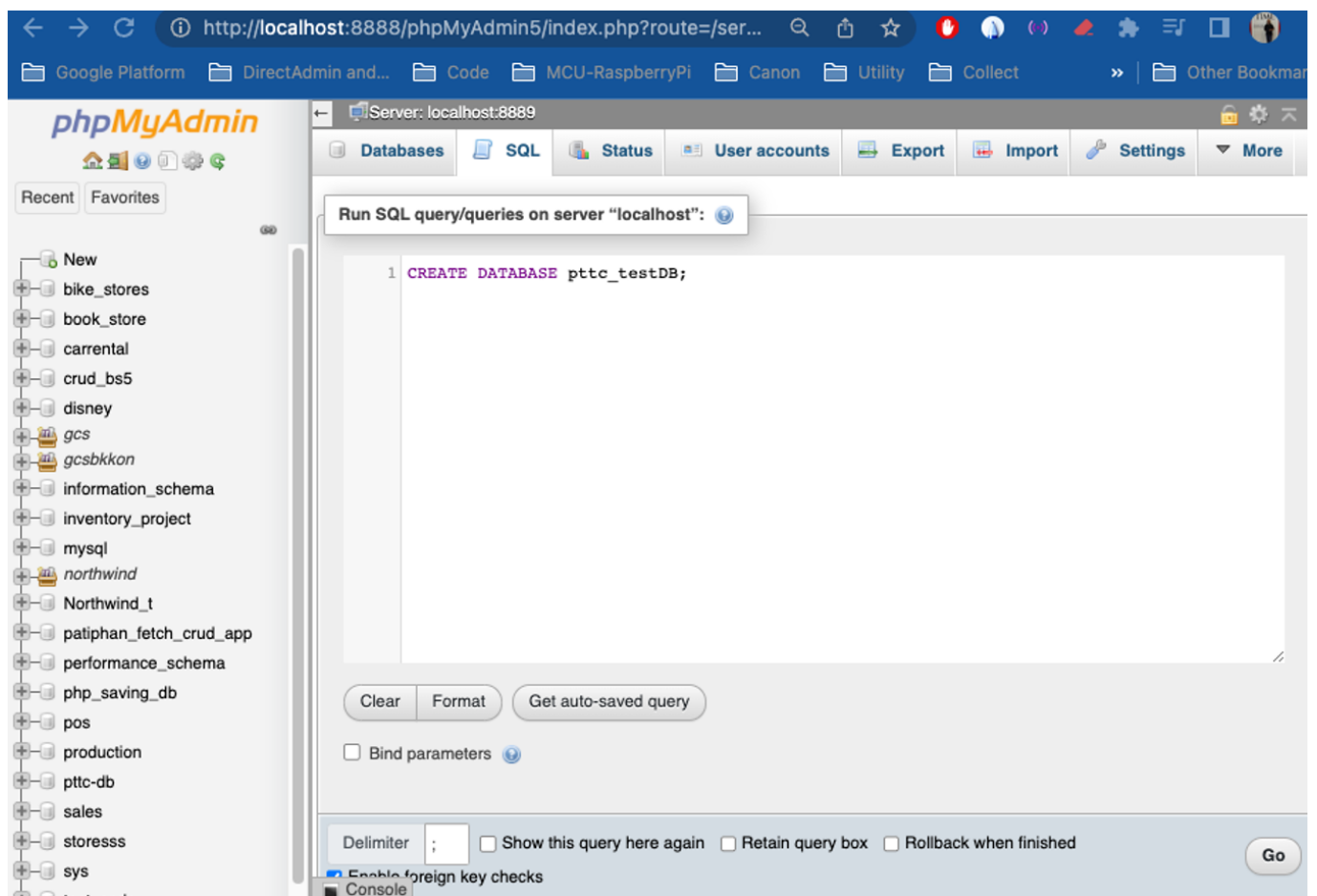

## CREATE DATABASE Example

The following SQL statement creates a database called "pttc\_testDB":

### Example 1

```
CREATE DATABASE pttc_testDB;
```



Tip: Make sure you have admin privilege before creating any database. Once a database is created, you can check it in the list of databases with the following SQL command: **SHOW DATABASES;**

```
SHOW DATABASES;
```

## DROP DATABASE Example

The DROP DATABASE statement is used to drop an existing SQL database.

The following SQL statement drops the existing database "pttc\_testDB":

### Example 1

```
DROP DATABASE pttc_testDB;
```
